## 1. Van Gompel Advocaten BV: Data Controller

# 3. Which personal data do we process, for what purpose and why can we do this?

#### **BROWSER AND SESSION DATA OF WEBSITE USERS**

We collect the following browser and session data **by means of cookies when you use our website**: the type of internet browser, user status, language preference, date and time of your visit, domain name or website through which you reached our website, number of visits, IP address, average time spent on our website and the pages visited.

#### **GOOGLE ADS**

VGA uses the services of Google Ireland Limited (Gordon House, Barrow Street, Dublin 4, Ierland) for Google Ads. When you use Google Ads to access our website, after agreeing to the terms of use of the Google search engine, **Google activates certain marketing cookies on our website**. This is in order to register that you are visiting us after using Google Ads.

Compliance with our legal and/or tax obligations, such as creating accounting records and invoices.	Compliance with legal obligations.

## (CONTACT) DATA OF NON-CLIENTS (OPPONENTS)

We process the following (contact) data of counterparties (counterparty) (and/or their team), **which** we have obtained from our clients and/or fellow lawyers: name, address, telephone number, email address, VAT and/or KBO number, and other personal data related to the file.

What for (purposes)?	This is allowed on the basis of (legal basis):

#### **SELECTION AND RECRUITING DATA OF APPLICANTS**

We collect the following selection and recruitment data when one is applying to VGA via our (group)website, email and or by telephone, or other channels (campus interviews, job fairs etc.): name, address, telephone number, email address, date of birth, curriculum vitae, and other documents and/or data that candidates provide us with.

What for (purposes)?	This is allowed on the basis of (legal basis):
Processing, managing and, where appropriate, following up on incoming applications.	Our legitimate interests, i.e., personnel management.

#### **CONTACT AND OTHER DATA OF OUR SUPPLIERS**

We collect the following contact and other data, among other things, from suppliers (and/or their team) when we negotiate and conclude commercial contracts with suppliers: (company) name, company form, address, telephone number, email address, VAT number and/or KBO number.

What for (purposes)?	This is allowed on the basis of (legal basis):
Using the services of our suppliers.	Our legitimate interests, in particular the use of third-party services.

#### **DATA SHARED THROUGH SOCIAL MEDIA**

When you post or share information on social media, the privacy policies of the social media providers will apply as far as the data processing by these social media providers is concerned.

VGA has an account, channel or (fan)page on LinkedIn, Instagram, Facebook, and YouTube (posting of videos) and is administrator of these accounts, channels or (fan)pages. As such, VGA is joint controller of the processing of your personal data when (art. 26 AVG): (i) VGA reposts your publications or interacts with you through these social media channels (e.g., via comments), (ii) you post or share information on the VGA social media accounts, pages, or channels, and (iii) VGA consults information concerning you through your (public) profile or on the pages of third parties/users.

So, these social media providers and VGA reached an agreement on their joint controllership rising from the aforementioned data processing flows, in order to fulfil the AVG requirements. Below, VGA provides you with more information on the personal data processing and the respective roles of VGA and the social media providers.



#### Why does VGA use your personal data on social media (purposes)?

VGA uses the information provided by you on our social media accounts, pages, or channels, as well as the information you have made publicly available in your profile or the profile(s) and/or page(s) of others, exclusively for **contacting you**, **if you requested us to do so and/or interact with you on social media regarding posts or topics of interest to us**.

VGA will not (i) store your personal data outside the concerning social media platform nor (ii) use your personal data for any other type of marketing or publicity.

VGA will only share your information through the social media platform itself. The only category of recipients of your information are the users of the social media platform concerned and people who are non-users with access to these platforms.

## Will VGA also use statistical information generated by the social media platforms (purposes)?

Social media providers generate statistical information on how its users use our (fan) page, account or, channel. This information is presented to us in anonymized formats. It does not allow us to draw conclusions regarding a specific individual user. Examples are the number of visits to our page, location and gender of the users/visitors, number of new followers etc.

We use this anonymized information to evaluate the success rate of our page, account, channel, and posts.

Apart from what is stated in this privacy policy, VGA has no influence whatsoever on nor is VGA involved in the processing of your personal data related to your activity, your page, account, or channel on social media.

## 4. Processing for direct marketing

## 5. Retention period

VGA does not store your personal data for longer than necessary for the processing purposes (see point 3) or as provided in our cookie policy unless VGA is required by law or court to keep the data for a longer period.

In the case of candidate applicants, we will store the personal data in our files for a maximum of 1 year in order to be able to inform the candidate applicants about any future and/or more suitable vacancies or vacancies.



## 6. Access to your personal data

VGA will treat your personal data confidentially. Unless the law or a court order imposes this on us, we will not transfer your data to third parties.

We sometimes use services and products from third parties (see below), who may gain access to (certain elements of) your personal data in order to provide their services or products. For example, for the maintenance and hosting of our website, marketing campaigns, legal software for managing clients and files, transferring legal documents and correspondence (for example, serving a summons).

VGA will conclude a processing agreement (as referred to in art.28 of the AVG) with these third parties. They hereby guarantee, among other things, that they will take the necessary technical and organizational measures to adequately protect your personal data and to only use your data in the context of and/or to realize the purposes provided for in this privacy policy.

## 8. Your rights concerning your personal data and how to exercise them

Regarding your personal data, you have the right, free of charge, to:

- Access to and inspection of your personal data and all information related to its processing;
- Correction of incomplete or inaccurate personal data;
- Deletion your personal data and limit their processing;
- Objection to all or certain purposes, in order for VGA to cease processing;
- Withdrawal of consent;
- Transfer of your personal data;
- Filing a complaint with the GBA (see 2).

If you do not wish to give us permission to process your data and/or withdraw your previous permission for this, it is possible that:

This will not affect the lawfulness of the processing based on your previous consent.

We will implement your requests to exercise your rights as soon as possible and at the latest within 15 working days.
